



Dr. Michele Garfinkel is the Manager of the EMBO Science Policy Programme. She is responsible for policy research focused on biotechnology and on scientific publishing. The Policy Programme also addresses responsible conduct of research, including the integration of concepts of gender equality into research integrity training.

Until March 2011 she was a policy analyst at the J. Craig Venter Institute. Her research there focused on identifying emerging societal concerns associated with new discoveries in genomics and crafting options for policy interventions. Her earlier work focused on health research policy and on stem cell policy issues.
