



**Maren A. Jochimsen** is Managing Director of the Essen College of Gender Studies EKfG, a central research institution of the University of Duisburg-Essen, Germany. The College's purpose is to foster interdisciplinary cooperation in the field of gender research by involving all faculties – medicine, the natural sciences, technology and engineering as well as the social sciences and humanities – in its research programme. Members of the College are affiliated at institutes at all three university locations: the campuses in Essen and Duisburg as well as the University's medical clinic in Essen, standing for a high potential of multi- and interdisciplinary cooperation.

Before joining the University of Duisburg-Essen in 2010, Maren A.
